THEY NEED A FAMILY

At Asia's Hope, we create *real families* — with permanent, full-time moms and dads — to provide the best possible environment for the orphaned kids in our care.

Institutional orphanages where children are treated as boarders by shift-workers produce, unsurprisingly, poor outcomes for the children they claim to serve.

THEY NEED A FUTURE

From the moment a child enters one of our family-style children's homes, parents and helpers begin to evaluate the child's unique physical, emotional and spiritual needs.

We work hard to provide the medical care, the nurture, the education and the job skills each child needs to succeed in life as an independent, successful adult.

THEY NEED HOPE

When our children were orphans, they had no hope, no promise of transformation. Each day offered only neglect and misery. In their new, loving families, our kids regain their lost innocence, achieve a sense of security and experience the life-changing power of hope.

CHURCH PARTNERS

We believe that God has special blessings in store for churches that respond to his call to “*defend the cause of the weak and the fatherless; maintain the cause of the poor and oppressed, rescue the weak and needy and deliver them from the hand of the wicked.*”

Our unique *church partnership model* is the primary means by which we rescue orphaned children and provide for their daily needs. Church partners develop a special relationship with the kids and staff at their Asia’s Hope home, and experience the joys of watching their kids grow and thrive.

Asia’s Hope provides video, print and email updates from the kids and staff, and facilitates annual short-term missions trips that provide opportunities to build relationships in-person.
