2. FUND A PROJECT



Everything changed for Grace Community Church on a cold winter Sunday morning three years ago. We were in the midst of series called “Raise the Bar,” and I had a message prepared called “Get Global.”



During that week God had been working on my heart in a strong way to challenge our people to see the world like he sees it. Our church has always been known for reaching others, yet God wanted us to do even more. I had been in contact with the directors of Asia’s Hope a few months prior to this and God planted a seed in my heart about this incredible grassroots ministry.

That morning I came ready to ask our people to consider giving enough money to support an orphanage in Cambodia and to help feed starving people in our world. I really sensed that God was going to work. So I gave the call to give, and God just blew us away. I had people writing checks before I even finished preaching and laying them on the stage. By the time the service was over, Grace Community people gave enough to support two orphanages and enough to feed a village with 100,000 meals. It was a Sunday that I will never forget.

It was the best decision that Grace Community has ever made. Now we get a chance to invest in over 40 children in two countries, Thailand and Cambodia. This relationship has changed the hearts of our people in an incredible way and God has blessed us over and above anything we could have ever imagined. May I encourage you today to do the same — your church will never be the same again. Besides, this is pure and faultless religion that God the Father loves!

When we started supporting Asia’s Hope, we could have never dreamed that it would transform our entire church.



As our church began to grow, I sensed that God was calling us to do something bigger, something more comprehensive. I didn’t just want to send money, I wanted to give people in the church the opportunity to have a real, lasting connection with a group of kids in Cambodia, and I wanted our whole church to participate through prayer, missions trips and through ongoing, long-term financial support.

I worked with Asia’s Hope to establish a budget, timeframe and multi-stage plan that would culminate in the rescue of 25 orphaned kids. The church responded so enthusiastically that we had all the money we needed within the first 15 minutes of the service!

Since that time, nearly every member of our church has been blessed by the opportunity to pour out God’s love to our “sister community,” the Prek Eng 2 Orphan Home. We’ve laughed with our kids in Cambodia, partied with them, cried with them, and worshipped together with them. Every time we send people over to visit our staff and kids, they come back energized and excited about what God is doing through our church on the other side of the world.

On my visits to our kids in Cambodia, I’ve been astounded at the transformation in their lives. God has used our church and Asia’s Hope to take these kids who had suffered so much — kids who had no hope — and turn them from battered refugees on the brink of disaster into a joyful, loving, Christian family. There is such a close relationship between our two communities — they are truly a part of our family.

Asia’s Hope has been one of the chief mechanisms our church has used to motivate, mobilize and deploy people into meaningful ministry.

Throughout the Bible, God proclaims his love for the orphan, the widow and the stranger. He commands his people to care for them, and promises them the resources to do so. I believe with my whole heart that God will bless any church that commits to partnering with him in the rescue and restoration of those whom he loves so dearly. He has certainly blessed ours. CAPITAL PROJECTS

Land and buildings for Prek Eng, Cambodia campus

Build a campus in Prek Eng, just outside of Phnom Penh, Cambodia.

This campus would house two homes, a school and worship center.

Land cost: \$116,400, Building cost: \$157,500

Development of Cambodian farm

Purchase fruit trees, pigpens, chicken and quail coops, livestock and equipment for our small farming project in Cambodia.

Project cost: \$4,100, Staffing cost: \$125 per month

Trucks for Cambodian and Thai children's homes

Buy three vehicles to transport kids and staff. Vehicle cost: \$12,200 each

Permanent building for Doi Saket 4 children's home

Build a permanent home on existing land for Doi Saket 4.

Funds needed to start construction: \$16,000

Truck caps for children's homes in Doi Saket, Thailand

Buy caps for pickup trucks at Doi Saket 3 and 4. Cost: \$1,710

Wall for children's home in Doi Saket, Thailand

Build a security wall for an orphan home. Construction cost: \$3,450

Laundry facilities for children's homes in Doi Saket, Thailand

Replace the roofs of four laundry facilities. Construction cost: \$1,014 per

Car park renovation for children's home in Doi Saket, Thailand

Replace the roof on the Doi Saket 1 car park. Construction cost: \$1,830

Furnishings for children's home in Doi Saket, Thailand

Shelves, tables and chairs for Doi Saket 1. Construction cost: \$1,790

EDUCATION PROJECTS

Learning center for Battambang, Cambodia children's homes
We're raising funds for a learning center for the kids at our six children's homes in Battambang, Cambodia.

Building cost: \$2,700, Computer cost: \$3,100 for 10 computers

Transitional living center for Battambang university students

We need to establish a residence for our kids in Battambang who have graduated high school and are attending college or vocational school.

Rent and utilities: \$500 per month, Staffing cost: \$500 per month,

One-time startup cost: \$1,600

University student scholarships

We want to ensure a college education or vocational training for our graduating students. **Books, tuition and transportation: \$1,100 per year**

EMERGING MINISTRY PROJECTS

India Vision Fund

We're actively recruiting and evaluating potential ministry partners in India in hopes of establishing children's homes by mid-2012. This fund will provide money for travel and legal expenses, and will allow us to hire a full-time director, director's assistant and establish a home office in India. **Fund target: \$38,400**

Start rescuing orphaned children



CHURCH PARTNERSHIP WITH ASIA'S HOPE

Through our church partnership model, your congregation can rescue orphaned children, give them parents and a home, meet their daily needs and embark upon a long-term relationship with those kids that will transform both your orphan home in Asia and your church.

And, depending on how things go, we can start as early as 2012!

Each Asia's Hope home operates as a family, not an institution. We hire godly couples as directors, and they become real fathers and mothers to the kids. They care for them as their own children, and are committed to a lifelong relationship with each child at the home.

As a church partner, your congregation will provide:

- All of the startup costs associated with rescuing the kids and establishing their household, usually around \$12,000.
- The monthly expenses related to food, shelter, medical care, education and staffing, usually around \$110 per child.

Asia's Hope will operate the home, hire and manage the staff, and integrate the children into our community of orphan homes.

We will also facilitate communication between the church and the home, and help plan trips so members of your staff and congregation can visit the project and create relationships that will last a lifetime.

Not sure you're ready to start a home right away? Sometimes it's a great idea to get your church acquainted with Asia's Hope by asking them to raise funds for a special project or one-time unrestricted gift.
