CAMBODIA

Suffering from a legacy of genocide and corruption, Cambodia is one of the world's poorest countries. The economy is in tatters and justice is routinely sold to the highest bidder. Tens of thousands of young children are forced to beg on Phnom Penh's dusty streets or sell their bodies as underage prostitutes.

THAILAND

Northern Thailand is home to a number of ethnic minority groups known broadly as "the hill tribes," each of which maintains its own culture, language and dress.

Political oppression and centuries-old cycles of poverty have left thousands of hill tribe children without parents, without education and without hope.

MULTI-DENOMINATIONAL

Asia's Hope is a distinctively Christian organization, founded on and governed by biblical principles, dedicated to extending God's love and mercy to the "fatherless and the widow." We are, however, distinctively and intentionally multi-denominational, welcoming involvement and input from a diverse cross-section of Christian groups and individuals and from non-Christians as well.



Asia's Hope is funded by generous donations from individuals and companies and by a network of church partners who “adopt” projects including orphan homes operations, land purchases and operational expenses vital to the organization's success.

Asia's Hope also offers supplemental sponsorships. For US\$35 per month, sponsors receive a picture and biography of a child along with periodic updates on the child and his or her home. These funds underwrite the costs to run Asia's Hope's 16 orphan homes.

Rice Farm in Cambodia

Project benefits: vocational training, food production and ongoing income for operations in Cambodia.

Investment: \$140,000 for 125 acres of prime rice fields, farm equipment, irrigation, and labor.

Net annual income: \$79,860



Land prices in Cambodia are at a five-year low. This unique opportunity may pass if we're unable to fund this project in 2010.

Wiang Pa Pow Campus

Project benefits: 22 acres of land suitable for future construction of three orphan homes, handicraft and vocational training centers, livestock and fruit farming.

Investment: \$125,000
